1. Chinese Cabbage - Granaat (=Michihili)

Maturity 70 - 75 days. Produces uniform, very long, cylindrical heads, approx. 10 cm. wide and 45 cm. high. Weight is approximately 1,5-2,0 kg. Leaves are deep green in colour and the heads blanch well. Deliciously crisp and tender. Seedlings are best grown at temp. of 15 C or higher to prevent bolting.




2. Red Cabbage - Bavero F1

Maturity is medium early, 70-75 days from transplanting. Plants have medium to large frames and moderately tall stems. Heads are round in shape, 1,2-1,5 kg in weight, purple red in colour and firm. Good quality for fresh market and industrial use.



3. Red Cabbage - Red Acre

Maturity is 75-80 days. Plants have a short stem. Heads are semi-globular in shape, 1,5-2,0 kg in weight and purple red in colour. Yellows tolerant.



4. Savoy Cabbage - Aubervilliers

Excellent, medium early savoy type cabbage. Plants are medium in size, vigorous and medium to dark green in colour. Heads are medium large, flattened globe in shape and weigh 1-1,5 kg. A fresh market and homegarden variety.



5. White Cabbage - Baracus F1

A very early and uniform Golden Acre type hybrid. Matures in 50-55 days from transplanting. Plants are small and compact so high plant densities are possible. Heads are round in shape with an average weight of 0,8-1,0 kgs.



6. White Cabbage - Bandung KKC F1

Bandung is an early maturing hybrid with excellent tolerance to heat. Plants are strong, medium to large in size and with semi-flat heads. Bandung is strong against Black Rot.



7. White Cabbage - Barabas F1

An early hybrid with uniform, ball shaped heads, medium sized with an average weight of 1.0-1.5 kg. Leaves are smooth and blue-green in colour. Excellent internal structure with short core. Slow bursting type, which makes a long harvest period possible. Maturity 60-65 days. Resistant to dry, wet and hot conditions.









8. White Cabbage - Balashi F1

This medium early hybrid is suitable for subtropical climates and tropical highlands. Plants are large with a blue-green colour. Heads are semi-round in shape, very firm and have an average weight of 2,8 kg. Balashi gives high yields and a nice uniform product.



9. White Cabbage - Cobalt F1

Maturity is 65-70 days. A medium-early maturing, round-headed hybrid with blue green waxy leaves, The head is medium large and solid weighing, 2,0-2,5 kg and has a short core. Tolerant to Black Rot, heat and drought. Wide adaptability.



10. White Cabbage - Batoe F1

Maturity 70-75 days. The heads are large, flat in shape and have medium green waxy leaves. The average weight of the heads is 3-4 kg. Highly recommended for the fresh market and industrial use.




11. White Cabbage - Express

Extra early variety. Small and compact plant size. Head colour is light green and head shape is conical. Head weight is 0.8-1.0 kg. Close planting.



12. White Cabbage - Golden Acre

A very early market cabbage, maturing in about 55 days from transplanting. Plants are very compact, with short stem and few outer leaves. This variety can be used for high plant-densities, up to 65.000 pl./ha. Heads are nice round in shape with green colour and weigh 0.8-1.2 kg.



13. White Cabbage - Copenhagen Market 3

Excellent selection of the well known Copenhagen Market type with early maturity. Suitable for fresh market. Plants have medium frame with short stem and with few outer leaves. Heads are round in shape, nice green in colour and weigh 1,5-2,0 kg on average.



14. White Cabbage - Jersey Wakefield

A distinctive early maturing variety, used for local markets and home gardens. Plants are relatively small and compact with dark green leaves. Heads are medium-small, rather compact and conical in shape. Heads weigh 1.2-1.6 kg. Slow bolting.









15. White Cabbage - Glory of Enkhuizen 2

Medium early variety. Plants are vigorous. Heads are round in shape, medium green in colour and weigh \pm 2,5 - 4,0 kg. Recommended for fresh market and kraut.



16. White Cabbage - Brunswick

A medium late, very popular variety for market and kraut. Plants are large in size and vigorous in growth. Heads are large in size, flat, bright green in colour and weigh about 2.5 - 3.5 kg. Widely adapted.



17. White Cabbage - Langedijker Bewaar 'Storado'

Excellent selection of Langedijker Storage (Holland Winter). Maturity is late (120-130 days from transplanting). Plants are medium large with rather tall stems. Heads are round in shape, dark green in colour, 2.5-3.0 kg in weight and very firm. Excellent variety for long storing.
