# Dwarf Slicing Beans









### 1. Green podded - Baroma VR

A flat podded dwarf bean in the Romano type, which can be picked multiple times. The broad, straight pods have a fleshy texture similar to that of runner beans and a very sweet taste. Pod length is 14 cm and pod width is 20 mm. Baroma VR has an upright plant habit which makes harvesting very easy. Resistant to Bean Common Mosaic Virus and Curly Top Virus.



#### 2. Green podded - Roma II

Green pods, string-less and uniform. Brown seeds (6-7 seeds per pod). Suitable for spring sowing in open field. The variety has good heat tolerance. Medium strong plant structure. Plant height is approx. 15-17 cm, with strong development. The pods are ready for harvesting after 48-50 days, and can be used for slicing.



#### 3. Green podded - Garrafal Enana

Dwarf Slicing Bean which can be grown on open field. Suitable for the fresh market. Plant height is medium and plant habit it medium open. Flowers are of a violet colour. Pods are flat and 20 cm long.



### 4. Green podded - Ceres

flat podded dwarfbean in the Romano type. The broad, straight pods have a fleshy texture similar to that of runner beans and a very sweet taste. The medium green flat pods have a length of 14 cm and are 20 mm wide. The plant grows very compact. Resistant to Curly Top Virus, Anthracnose and Bean Common Mosaic Virus.



## 5. Purple podded - Purpiat

A purple, flat podded, Romano type variety. The pods will loose their purple colour whilst cooking and will turn into very attractive dark green. High yielding stringless variety with excellent taste. Ready to pick in 53 days



## 6. Yellow podded - Supernano giallo

A black seeded dwarf slicing bean with a light-medium yellow pod colour. Pod length is 16 cm and has a diameter of 20 mm. Medium open plant habit.



# 7. Yellow podded - Merveille de Piemonte

The yellow pods with purple stripes make Merveille de Piemonte very appealing. The fleshy pods are stringless, flat, 18 cm long and 17 mm wide and suitable for slicing.









#### 8. Yellow podded - Odir

A new, yellow, Romano type variety. Odir has a strong upright plant habit and dark, yellow, fleshy pods with a length of 14 cm and a diameter of 20 mm. Suitable for processing. The variety is resistant to Bean Common Mosaic Virus, Halo Blight, and Anthracnose.
