CRISPHEAD TYPE

1. Chou de Naples (=Webb's Wonderful)

Crisphead variety with large heads. Leaves are medium dark green. Heat tolerant and white seeded



2. <u>Great Lakes 118</u>

Medium early crisphead variety. The large heads are glossy-dark green with very good solidity and with good wrapper leaves. Widely adapted and tolerant to tipburn. Recommended for Summer and Autumn production. Withstands shipping very well.




3. Barkos

Barkos is an improved Great Lakes type which is heat tolerant. The heads are medium large and the leaf colour is dark green. A white seeded variety.



4. Barego

Beautiful, shiny, brown-red coloured crisphead lettuce. Heads are large in size with brown-red outer leaves. Inner leaves are fresh-green. For spring, summer and autumn use. Black seeded



5. Great Lakes 659

Medium early crisphead variety. The large heads are glossy-dark green with very good solidity and with good wrapper leaves. Widely adapted and tolerant to tipburn. Recommended for Summer and Autumn production. Withstands shipping very well.



6. Saladin

A popular crisphead variety with good uniformity, producing large sized, very well-closed, solid heads. Saladin is very strong against dry tipburn and to be recommended for spring and autumn crops in the Mediterranean area and summer crops in Northern Europe. A standard crisphead variety for shipping.



7. Topper

A firm crisphead desert type lettuce with a large frame with tolerance to heat and cold conditions. Topper matures in approximately 95-100 days, is dark green in colour and offers tolerance to Tip burn.









BATAVIA TYPE

1. Robaco

Robaco is an attractive semi-red lettuce type between red Batavia and red Lollo. The strong standing, rather small, attractive plant produces a small, round, semi-filled head. Leaves are medium dark reddish-green and rather frilled. Close plantings are possible.



2. Babylon

Babylon is a medium-early Batavian type lettuce for spring and autumn production. The strong standing, healthy plants produce a round, well-filled, closed head with blond to medium green inner leaves and bronze-red outer leaves. Leaves are shiny. For home and market use.



3. <u>Doree de printemps</u>

A Batavia Type which matures in approx. 75 days. The head size is medium large and solid. Leaf colour is light green. Seed colour is white.



4. Blonde de Paris

A medium-large heading variety in the Batavian lettuce type. Very attractive light-green in colour, crispy and leafy. Its sweet, tender leaves are frilled and crumpled, with wavy margins. Solid heads. White seeded



5. De Pierre benite

Batavia type lettuce with medium large head. Leaves are light green and heads are large and solid. White seeded



6. <u>Icebera 4</u>

Medium maturing Batavian type lettuce with broad leaves and large heads. Leaves are medium green, wavy, slightly crumpled and bronze tinged. Heads are medium-large, well-filled, closed and light green with red tinge. White seeded. For home and market use.









COS ROMAINE TYPE

1. Sucrine (=Little Gem)

Sucrine is an early, semi-Cos type variety, recommended for winter crops in the Mediterranean area and summer crops in Northern Europe. Plants are small, with upright heads, which are solid and compact. Leaves are thick, brilliant and medium-green curled.



2. Winter Density

An early, semi-Cos type variety recommended for winter crops in the Mediterranean area. Plants are small, with upright heads, which are solid and compact. Leaves are thick and brilliant, dark green curled.



3. Blonde maraichere

Cos Romaine Type with a medium early maturity. Heads are medium sized and well-closed. Leaf colour is light green, seed colour is white.



4. Lobioits Green Cos 'Panama'

Lobjoits Green is a dark green Romaine variety, which matures in approximately 70 days from direct sowing. Plants are medium-large, upright and self-folding. Leaves are broad, long, slightly savoyed, slightly crumpled and sweet in flavour. Self-blanching hearts.



5. Bacor

Cos-Romaine type for hot and dry areas. Medium early maturity. Plants are medium large with dark green leaves, which are slightly savoyed. Well-formed head, slow bolting. Tolerant to Tipburn and Lettuce Mosaic Virus. Excellent yielder. White seeded.



6. Baricos

Excellent Cos type for hot and dry areas. Medium early. Plants are large, tall and upright. Leaves are dark green, large, thick and slightly savoyed. Good tolerance to bolting and tipburn.



7. Parris Island Cos

Excellent Cos type for hot and dry areas. Medium early. Plants are large, tall and upright. Leaves are dark green, large, thick and slightly savoyed. Slow bolting. Good tolerance to tipburn and Mosaic.









COS ROMAINE TYPE

8. Tender

Tender is a medium green Cos/Romaine variety recommended for planting in summer and winter. Leaves are medium-green, broad, crinkled and sweet in flavour. Heads are large, upright and firm. Excellent bolting and heat resistant. Medium early.



9. Recoba

Red coloured Cos/Romaine type for spring, summer and autumn production. Medium early maturity. Upright plants with bronze-red coloured leaves, which are slightly savoyed and blistered. 'Heads' a re well-formed, closed and slow to bolt. Excellent yielder. Also for salad mixtures and babyleaf.









LOOSE LEAVE TYPE

1. Lollo Bionda 'Crespo'

An improved selection in the Lollo bionda type, which is more tolerant to bolting and faster in growth. Very attractive light-green in colour, crispy and leafy. Its sweet, tender leaves are very frilled and crumpled. The small, erect, non-heading plants mature in about 50 days and are resistant to tipburn. Can be sown all year round as well as indoors and outdoors.



2. Lollo rossa 'Assor'

Slow bolting, improved selection of the Lollo rossa type. Assor has a very attractive ruby red colour. Leaves are sweet, tender and strongly frilled and crumpled. Plants are erect, mature in about 50 days and are resistant to tipburn.



3. Lucifer

Slow bolting, Lollo rossa type, with very attractive extra dark red colour. The sweet, tender leaves are very frilled and crumpled, with wavy margins. The rather small, erect, non-heading plants mature in about 45 days and are resistant to tipburn. Can be sown all year round as well as indoors and outdoors, holding its dark red colour very well. Also for baby leaf and salad mixtures.



4. Barocci

Barocci is our extra dark red looseleaf variety. In every lettuce field Barocci can be noticed from far away due to its remarkable, extremely dark red colour. Probably it is the darkest red leaf lettuce in the world. Plants are large, erect growing and vigorous. Leaves are large and rather smooth. Suitable for production all year round. Slow to bolt. Excellent for salad mixtures and babyleaf.



5. Barosso

Mid early, looseleaf type with dark, ruby red colour, looking attractive and appetizing. Large plants are uniform in growth and holds well in the field. Leaves are broad, wavy and crumpled. Outer colour is ruby red, inner colour is green. Slow bolting. Even in warmer season it shows good red coloration. Performs also well in cool climates. White seeded. Matures in about 55 days.



6. Bassali

Bassali is our dark green version of the green Salad Bowl. It is larger, more vigorous and darker green in colour than the standard green "oak leaf" types. Bassali can be grown all year round and performs well on all soil types. Its appearance and flavour are very attractive. Excellent uniformity and strong against bolting. Excellent for salad mixtures



7. Delicato

Delicato is our Red Salad Bowl variety with extra dark red colour all year round. Therefore this eye-catcher can be grown outdoors in different climates all year round. Already in a young stage this fresh dark Red Salad Bowl is fine, deeply lobbed and coloured up to the base. It can be used in every salad mix. Delicato is strong against bolting and has an excellent flavour.

Bared is a late variety with a large head size. Seed colour is black. A very uniform variety with a beautiful red coloured oakleaf.

9. Salad Bowl 'Dallas'

Dallas is an improved selection of the well-known variety Salad Bowl with outstanding uniformity. Maturity is approx. 60 days. Plants are large in size. Leaves are oak-leaved in shape and medium green. Slow bolting selection. Black seeded.







BUTTERHEAD TYPE

1. Tom Thumb

Very early variety with small, compact plants. Leaf-colour is medium to light green. Suitable for home gardens. The outside leaves are small and fit snugly to the head. Leaves are a little crumpled. Heart is firm and tender. The earliest and smallest butterhead. Can be planted very close together.



2. Kagraner Sommer 2 'Bakaso'

A brilliant green butterhead variety for summer outdoor production. The round and well-closed heads have rather thick, wavy leaves. Bakaso is strong against tipburn and bolting. Excellent heat resistance in summer conditions.



3. May Queen

Early butterhead variety for spring cultivation indoors and outdoors with medium small heads. Leaves are light to medium green with red tinge.



4. Nansen's Noordpool (=Arctic King)

Old butterhead type for autumn sowing and early spring production in open field. Heads are medium small, well-filled and with medium green leaves. Survives a soft winter better than many other sorts and is quick to reach maturity. If Arctic King is sown from spring until autumn, plants will bolt quickly.



5. Madrilene

Madrilene is a medium early variety with a medium large head. The leaf colour is dark green and the seed is black. Madrilene is tolerant to heat.



6. Attraktion

Early maturing, standard butterhead variety for spring, summer and autumn production (open field). Heads are medium large, pale green, with solid heads and buttery yellow heart. Excellent tender quality. Strong against diseases.



7. Merveille des quatre saisons 'Rosita'

A dark red butterhead lettuce with medium sized heads. Plants are fairly compact and early. Outer leaves are intense red in colour, inner leaves are light green. Recommended for spring, summer and autumn crops.







BUTTERHEAD TYPE


8. Tetue de Nimes

Very slow bolting "Grasse-type" lettuce for hot climate areas. Heads are medium large, medium green and with firm solidity. Leaves are large, thick and smooth. Resistant to tipburn and heat.

9. All The Year Round

Butterhead variety for spring, summer and autumn production (open field). Heads are medium large, medium green, with solid heads and buttery yellow heart. Excellent tender quality. Black seeded. Popular home garden variety.



10. Grosse blonde paresseuse

Large, butterhead variety with light green, smooth leaves and well-filled large heads. Medium-late variety especially for summer cultivation. Slow to bolt. White seeded.
