RED / PINK

1. Red / Pink Onion Red King F1

Early short day onion for fresh market. Bulb: topshape, medium size, firm, red exterior colour, red inner scales, tight outer scales. Medium to thin neck. Fair storage quality. Bolting tolerance good, with due regard to planting date. Low pungency.



2. Red / Pink Onion Red Creole

A popular short day variety specially recommended for tropical areas. The medium sized bulbs are red, thick-flat in shape and pungent. Red Creole matures in about 185 days from sowing and has good storage quality. Pink Root resistant.



3. Red / Pink Onion Red Bombay

Strong growing, short day variety for hot and dry areas. Bulbs are medium large, semi round in shape and red in colour. Flesh is firm and pungent. Medium late maturity.



4. Red / Pink Onion Violet De Galmi

Tropical short day onion. Bulbs are thick-flat, uniform light purple colour. Very thin neck. Excellent bulb storage ability (ambient conditions, well ventilated storage: 3 to 6 months). Maturity: 130-140 days from direct sowing.



5. Red / Pink Onion Bronze d'Amposta

Intermediate-long day variety (30-45° latitude) with late maturity. Bulbs are very large, globe shaped and red/bronze in colour. Flesh is mild, firm and white tinted pink. Excellent variety for long storing.









1. White Onion White Grano

Short day, white skin onion with medium maturity. Bulbs are large top shaped with low pungency. Short term storage ability. Productive and tolerant to Pink Root..



2. Bunching Onion White Lisbon

Grown almost exclusively as a green bunching variety. It has a clear white shank and a savory mild flavour. When full grown, the bulbs are soft, white, flattened globe and with delicious flavour. Early maturity. For spring, summer and autumn use



3. Bunching Onion Long White Ishikura (Allium Fistulosum)

Early maturing spring onion. Suitable for spring and autumn sowing. Long, pure white stalks, up to 50 cm long. It shows almost no splitting and grows like leek. Hilling at the proper time is recommended. Heavy yielder with excellent uniformity. Tender and delicious taste.









YELLOW

1. Yellow Onion Afrigold F1

Extra early, short day onion for fresh market. Bulb: rounded top shape, small/medium size, firm, yellow exterior colour, tight outer scales and thin neck. Fair storage quality. Bolting tolerance good, with due regard to planting date. Pungent flavour.



2. Yellow Onion Bacoli F1

Bacoli is an early, very high yielding hybrid suitable for growing in short day areas . Bulbs are rather large and have a flattened globe shape. The skin is strong and dark yellow in colour. The flesh is slightly pungent and firm. Medium long storage ability.




3. Yellow Onion Espresso F1

Early short day onion for fresh market. Bulb: globular shape, small/medium size, firm, deep straw exterior colour, tight outer scales and medium to thin neck. Fair storage quality. Bolting tolerance good, with due regard to planting date. Pungent flavour



4. Yellow Onion Soprano F1

Medium maturing, intermediate day onion. Bulb: flattened globe shape, medium-large size, firm, dark yellow exterior colour, tight outer scales. Good storage quality. Bolting tolerance good, with due regard to planting date. Medium pungent flavour.



5. Yellow Onion Dubai F1

Late intermediate, long day onion. Bulb: globular shape, medium-large size, firm, dark straw-yellow exterior colour, tight outer scales. Very good storage quality. Bolting tolerance good, with due regard to planting date. Medium pungent flavour. Pink Root resistant.



6. Yellow Onion Stuttgarter Riesen

Medium early variety, which is very suitable to grow from onion-sets. Bulbs are medium large, thick-flat in shape and yellow in colour. Firm skin. Excellent variety for storage.



7. Yellow Onion Texas Early Grano 502 PRR

Texas early grano 502 PRR is a very popular short day variety (<38° Latitude). It has an early maturity. The bulbs have a strawu2011yellow coloured skin, top shape and rather large size. The flesh is firm and mild. Texas early grano 502 PRR is resistant to Pink Root. Limited storage is possible.









YELLOW

8. Onion Senshyu Yellow

Senshyu Yellow is a medium early, yellow onion for shortday overwintering use. Bulbs are large, semi-globe in shape and have a mild flavour. A heavy yielder with good storage ability.



9. Yellow Onion Sweet Spanish

A high yielding variety of good quality and attractive appearance, giving large bulbs, up to 8 cm in diameter, with an round to globe shape. Firm white flesh with a tough, brown yellow skin and mild flavour. Medium-long storage ability. Maturity is medium late, approximately 120 days from sowing. Suitable for long-day/semi-short-day segment areas (38°-45° latitude) as a summer crop.



10. Yellow Onioçn Rijnsburger 5 'Balusta'

Balusta is an improved selection in the Rijnsburger type for long-day use. The onions are globe shaped, yellow-brown in colour and have very strong skin. Dry matter content is approximately 12%. Balusta is a highly productive variety and can be stored, under controlled conditions, up to 7-8 months.
