<u>USES</u>

For prevention & treatment of coccidiosis in broilers caused by Eimeria Aceruwina, E. Brunettl, E. Maxima, E. Miti, E. Mivati, Maduramycin is also effective against most gram-positive bacteria, against some fungi and against some gram-negative bacteria. Maduramycin has no intersecting medicine-resistance with other antibiotics.

DOSAGE

500 gm/ton for Maduramycin 1 % feed additive in finished feed 50 gm/ton for Maduramycin 10 % feed additive in finished feed. The test result 5 ppm can completely control the various coccidiosis symptoms in broiler chickens.

WARNING

1) Birds should not be slaughtered for human consumption during treatment or until 5 days thereafter.

2) Do not use along with Tiamulin and Furazolidone.

Packed in plastic bag, net weight 25 kg.
