SICOBLACK 18-22

Black Disinfectant

Code N° CD30

DESCRIPTION

SICOBLACK 18-22 is a stable black fluid formulated from selected coal tar oils, creysylic acids and soaps. It mixes readily with water to produce characteristic milky white emulsions.

SICOBLACK 18-22 has good freeze thaw stability and can be stored in concentrated form for a long period, even under tropical conditions.

APPLICATIONS

As an economical general-purpose disinfectant, **SICOBLACK 18-22** is commonly used at a dilution of 1:300 water for the disinfection of drains, sinks, urinals, dustbins and gulleys. Not suitable for use in food storage or preparation areas.

TOXICITY

Poison, contains 20-30% v/v phenols. NOT TO BE TAKEN.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Wash splashes from eyes immediately.
- Store tightly closed in a safe place away from children.
- Wash out container thoroughly and dispose of safely.
- Do not mix with other chemicals (except those recommended by manufacturer).
- Keep concentrate and diluted product off skin, wash splashes immediately.
- Wash after use.
- Do not contaminate ponds, waterways or ditches.
- Do not use the product in situations where tainting of food products may occur. e.g. in drains under markets.
- The product is flammable. Flash point greater than 66°C (150°F).
- Store away from sources of heat and ignition.
- Extinguishing agents: Dry chemical foam or water spray equipment.

FIRST AID AND MEDICAL ADVICE

In cases of swallowing and poisoning:

- Medical attention must be sought immediately.
- Give the patient generous quantities of liquid e.g. lime water, chalk water, milk, milk of magnesia, barley water or plain water to dilute and help neutralise the phenols present.
- Apply warmth to the extremities.
- If any respiratory difficulties or loss of consciousness is evident - oxygen should be administered.

In cases of skin splashes and burns from the concentrate:

- Remove any contaminated clothing and wash affected areas immediately with soap and warm (not hot) water.
- If badly splashed or burned wash as above and rub area with a swab soaked in a mixture of 70 parts Polyethylene Glycol and 30 parts Methylated Spirits or a swab soaked with a little Eucalyptus Oil for 10 minutes.
- If extremely badly effected, remove contaminated clothing, wash as above, treat for shock and artificial respiration, administer oxygen if required and seek medical assistance.

N.B. For splashes from dilutions of the disinfectant it is normally sufficient to wash with cold or warm water only.

In cases of eye splashes from concentrate and dilutions:

- Irrigate immediately with buffered Phosphate solution or water or milk if solution is not available, for at least 10 minutes.
- Seek medical assistance or advice as soon as possible in cases involving splashes of concentrate or bad cases involving the diluted product.
