1) INTRODUCTION & BASIC INFORMATION

The SICO-ECOSULF MICRO 800SC fertilizer is made of ground elemental sulfur, which allows for its effective use by plants, reaching about 80%. Increases the resistance of crops to diseases and pests, as well as frost and drought. It also increases the taste and aroma of plants.

SICO-ECOSULF MICRO 800SC is recommended primarily for use on soils with sulfur deficiency. On arable land, the fertilizer is intended for sulfur-loving plants, i.e. cruciferous plants - rape, turnip rape, mustard, cabbage, swedes, turnips and legumes: horse beans, peas.

Favorable yield-forming results are also obtained after applying the fertilizer for maize and cereals. The fertilizer can also be used on agricultural land adapted to the cultivation of grasses (meadows and pastures) or other herbaceous crops, both natural and resulting from agricultural activities.

2) PREPARATION AND APPLICATION

The liquid solution should be prepared just before carrying out the fertilization treatment. Before starting the preparation of the spray liquid, shake the contents of the package and carefully measure out the required amount of fertilizer. Dissolve the measured dose of fertilizer in water, and then mix thoroughly in the sprayer tank. To do this, pour fertilizer into the sprayer tank partially filled with water. Then fill the sprayer tank with water to the required concentration. Rinse the emptied containers three times with water and pour the rinsings into the sprayer tank with working liquid.

Thoroughly wash the sprayer after work. Dilute remains of unused spray liquid with water and spray on the previously sprayed surface. The fertilizer is applied in the form of medium or fine spraying with sprayers used in plant protection. Spraying should be done on cloudy days, in the evening or in the morning, applying evenly over the entire surface. Fields and crops not intended for this should not be fertilized. In the recommended concentration, the fertilizer does not cause corrosion of the sprayer's working parts.

3) RECOMMENDATIONS FOR USE

1. Do not exceed the recommended concentration of the spray liquid.

2. Do not spray the plants in strong sunlight and high temperatures; the fertilizer is best applied in the morning (after dew disappears) or in the late afternoon.

3. It is not recommended to apply the fertilizer just before rainfall or during rainfall.

4. Physically or mechanically damaged plants and those attacked by diseases and pests

should not be fertilized.

5. It is not recommended to spray the plants during flowering.

4) STORAGE

Keep away from sources of heat and light. Do not expose to strong sunlight. Keep only in the original packaging at a temperature not lower than 0 ° C.

5) EXPIRATION DATE

24 months from the production date, under the conditions of storage.
